### **Sports Week**

Class teachers will let parents know when this will be so that children can come in their PE kit on the day.

### **Mobile Testing Unit**

On Wednesday next week ( June 30th) there will be a mobile PCR testing unit based in our school car park( area in front of the old school building on Irlam Road) as part of Trafford Public Health's enhanced case finding procedure. This is open to all in the area—just turn up—no need to book. It is for anyone without symptoms and is intended to help identify asymptomatic covid infections in the community. Officers from public health will be outside school on Tuesday to answer any questions before the unit arrives on Wednesday. As this is case finding, participants do not need to isolate whilst awaiting the result. Further details inside this newsletter.

## Coronavirus Update

We have had further cases of covid in school this week and cases reported in pupil households. We wish to thank all parents for responding so quickly when we have requested that pupils are collected. We understand the frustrations caused when 'bubbles' close and the impact on everyone. Increased case rates in the area are now impacting on our school community.

We are acting on advice from public health and using DFE guidance when we close 'bubbles'. Whilst it is believed that daily LFD testing may be a way of curtailing isolation in the near future, it is not in place yet and isolating pupils should stay in their own homes and gardens.

### Mobile Testing Unit

As you may know, Trafford Council will be carrying out additional Covid-19 testing at our school on Wednesday 30th June. This is because of an increasing number of cases within our school community. We have been asked to take part in additional testing, using a 'PCR test' which is processed in a laboratory. To help keep our friends, family and colleagues safe, we are inviting all parents and staff to be tested on Wednesday.

We will have a Mobile Test Unit on the school car park where you and your family can come and get tested. You don't have to book, just turn up any time between 8am and 4:30pm.

To receive your test result, you must register your test. After you have completed your test, go to [www.gov.uk/register-your-test](http://www.gov.uk/register-your-test) or call 119. The test results will be then communicated directly to you. There will be staff available to support this process should you need it.

If you or your child tests positive, has any symptoms of Covid-19, or are contact traced following contact with someone who tests positive, then you and your family should self-isolate immediately in line with the guidance on GOV.UK.

The more cases we find, the better chance we have at stopping it spreading. Please help to keep our school safer by participating in the testing.

As the testing offered on Wednesday is part of a case finding exercise there is no requirement to self-isolate whilst you are waiting for your result. However under normal circumstances if you need to take a PCR test you must self-isolate until the results are known.

All pupils and staff should continue to follow national guidance, including 'hands, face, space, fresh air' and take a rapid LFD Covid-19 test twice a week, even if you don't have symptoms.

Some of the team will be there the day before to remind you about the Mobile Testing Unit and to talk to you about your experiences of Covid-19. Please take a minute to talk to them, particularly if you have any concerns.

We would really appreciate your full support of this important public health exercise.
